“REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT”

It is a requirement of the Club By-Laws to obtain membership to the Bayside Off-Roaders 4WD Club INC., and to participate in any club activity which requires the use of a four wheel drive vehicle, that all members complete and sign this application form in its entirety. Any prospective members that have more than one vehicle and wish to have such vehicles registered with their membership must carry the required safety equipment as listed below, in any vehicle used in any club activity that requires the use of a four wheel drive vehicle.

It is a further requirement of Bayside Off-Roaders Club INC. that anyone wishing to drive on a trip rated above scenic/easy must have completed an accredited basic off-road driver training course or equivalent.

All club members that own more than one vehicle are required to complete a separate “Required Safety Equipment” form for each vehicle.

A new form is to be completed when a member changes vehicles, acquires a new vehicle and upon Membership renewal each year.
